In 1948 the Faculty of History of Kazakh State University converted from department to a separate Faculty. There are many outstanding academics such as: A.M. Pankratova, S.N. Pokrovsky, corresponding member of the Kazakh SSR, doctor of historical sciences, professor E.B. Bekmakhanov contributed of its formation. At the same year was the first graduation of 18 professional historians. During the first years on the faculty worked ten people and studied 300 students, then today employs more than 80 teachers, including 27 doctors and 40 candidates of historical sciences and 5 PhD. The scientific school of professors T.O. Omarbekov, K.T. Zhumagulov, K.S. Karazhan, J.C. Taimagambetov, K.M. Atabayev, W.H. Shalekenov, A.T.Toleubayev were established and successfully operate nowadays.









Faculty provides training in the three-step system: Bachelor, Master and PhD. By 2014, the faculty prepared more than 10,000 students, hundreds of undergraduates and 5 PhD. Many representatives of the scientific, political and business elite, who work in different parts of Kazakhstan are graduates of the faculty. Specialist who graduated from the Faculty of History, Archeology and Ethnology acquires a wide range of fundamental knowledge in the field of history, archeology, political science, and culture. Knowledge of foreign languages and the possibility of wide contacts during their studies allow students to find interesting and challenging work. Graduates of the faculty demand not only in education and science, but also in diplomatic and administrative work, Armed forces and lawenforcement bodies affairs, National Security Committee, etc.



In execution of point of the Protocol of enlarged meeting of the Interdepartmental working group on studying of national history under the chairmanship of the State secretary of the Republic of Kazakhstan, on the basis of the decision of the Academic council of the al-Farabi Kazakh National University is created International laboratory «Geoarcheology» (protocol №12 June 24 2013 y.)

LABORATORY'S PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose of laboratory is use of variety of methods of naturalscience disciplines when studying and dating archaeological sites and artifacts in the territory of Kazakhstan and Central Asia through a prism of world history on the basis of modern methodological paradigms and tools.

Main objectives

- the formulation and justification of problems of natural-science researches when studying archaeological sites and a museefication of objects of historical and cultural heritage, and also definition of requirements at each stage of measurements;
- formation of approaches for development of methods of interpretation of geoarcheological data and recovery of spatial characteristics of archaeological objects;
- creation of complex and software for visualization, processing and interpretation of geoarcheological data;
- experimental approbation of a method, technique and technology at researches of the sites, occurring at different times, located in various landscape zones;
- development of recommendations about application of natural-science methods in field archaeological researches, definition of restrictions and necessary conditions of their effective use, etc.

The main personnel structure of laboratory consists of 18 executors, from them 7 doctors of science, 7 candidates of science, 4 doctoral candidates, leaders scientists from the USA, Japan, Germany, Russia, etc.

EXPECTED RESULS

- Reliability of results is proved by high precision of measurement of width of year rings (not less 0,05 mm);
- obligatory application of each individual chronology for control of correctness of the executed measurements of procedure of cross dating in the GROWLINE program;
- use of modern methods of statistical processing of a material with use of the tabular Microsoft Excel processor, STATISTICA 6.0 program; the considerable volume of the analyzed material;
- as a result of functioning of Department of Paleobiology will be studied as an environment in detail (climate, vegetation, paleogeography) separate archaeological objects and sites, and complete information on environment change for the last 50 000 years on the basis of what regularities of change of types of managing will be revealed, migratory processes, conditions of formation and fading of various cultures in the territory of Kazakhstan is collected, features of life support and a life are defined;
- the technological analysis is capable to give a material for studying of personal or ethnic features in a production activity of the person. Thus, methods of the technological and functional analysis it is possible to carry out search, fixing, definition and interpretation of traces of some psychological stereotypes in materials of archaeological collections of Paleolithic era, to see the materialized individual and group specifics of thinking of the person.

Republic Scientific-Research Center "Studying of traditional civilizations of Central Asia"

According the decision of the Scientific Council of the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University Republic research center "Studying of traditional civilizations of Central Asia" was established at the Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.

Appointed director of the Center for the Study of the famous scholar of history of ancient Turkic tribes, doctor of historical sciences, professor, head of the Department of history of Kazakhstan Omarbekov Talas.

The purpose of the Center is to develop the scientific problems of traditional civilization of Kazakhstan and Central Asia on the basis of historical and comparative analysis, and new methodological approaches in the context of a critical re-evaluation of methods of knowledge in the world historiography.



The main objectives

Identify the specific characteristics of nomadic origin, formation and decay of evolving for thousands of years and the early medieval state formations in the ancient Turkic steppe that have had a major impact on the ethnogenesis of the many people of the world;

determine diplomatic and trade-economic role of the Silk Road, its influence on the formation of social organization and the ethno-political structures ulus control systems of "Dasht-i -Kipchak nomads";

investigate the processes of formation ethnoterritory, tribal area that formed the Kazakh ethnicity, history of Eurasian toponymy, political and cultural aspects of the relationship with the nomads of the steppes and bordering sedentary nations of Central Asia;

to identify the roots of ethnic and cultural base and civilizational identity of the Turkic people, the community and the continuity of the traditional economy and culture of the nomads of Central Asia, etc.

The structure of the center is represented by the following sectors:

- 1. The historiography of traditional culture of Central Asia
- 2. The history of the steppe empires of Eurasia
- 3. Ethnogenesis of the Kazakh people
- 4. The history of relations between the nomads of Central Asia and neighboring nations
- 5. Social and ethno-cultural structure of traditional Dasht-i Kipchak society

For the scientific development of 17 proposed projects on a variety of topics shows the work of the Centre. The main staff of the Centre consists of 38 performers, including 13 doctors, 16 candidates, 1 PhD, 6 PhD students, including the well-known specialists of the republic, as well as leading academics from the U.S., Japan, Turkey, China, such as Yulai Shamiloglu, Ahmet Tashsgil, Uyamo Tomahiko etc.



Expected results

Collect and systematize Kazakhs oral historiology materials, datas from the archives and libraries of Kazakhstan, CIS and foreign countries;

Issue annual scientific collection titled "Orkeniet";

Publication of monographs connected with the history of ethnogenesis of Dasht-i Kipchak Turkic-speaking tribes;

Publication of the periodical press and speech in the media, organizing online conferences, round-table discussions on the issues of traditional civilizations of Central Asia;

Introduce scientific results and conclusions in the learning process in the system of secondary and higher education institutions: the creation of textbooks, electronic teaching materials, teaching aids, reading elective courses on nomadism and in common the traditional civilizations of Central Asia, publish workshops and chrestomathies.

Main tasks:

- Explore the historical experience of European integration and modernization in order to determine a distinctive path of development and modernization of Kazakhstan's society and the prospects for its future growth;
- organization and conduct of scientific research on priority areas of modern science;
- to make a critical analysis of the existing Western theoretical concepts about the role, place and value of Turkic peoples in the history of the world to develop new modern conceptual approaches;
- comprehensively explore, organize and critically reflect on the western historiography history of Central Asia, Kazakhstan to summarize experience of Western Europe in the study of the Turkic world;
- holding publishing and joint publishing projects with similar organizations in the country and abroad;
