**The program of the entrance exam for applicants to the
PhD for the group of educational programs
D055-«Oriental studies»**

1. General provisions.

1. The program was drawn up in accordance with the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 31, 2018 No. 600 “On Approval of the Model Rules for Admission to Education in Educational Organizations Implementing Educational Programs of Higher and Postgraduate Education” (hereinafter referred to as the Model Rules).

2. The entrance exam for doctoral studies consists of writing an essay, passing a test for readiness for doctoral studies (hereinafter referred to as TRDS), an exam in the profile of a group of educational programs and an interview.

3. The duration of the entrance exam is 3 hours 10 minutes, during which the applicant writes an essay, passes a test for readiness for doctoral studies, and answers an electronic examination. The interview is conducted on the basis of the university before the entrance exam.

2. Procedure for the entrance examination.

1. Applicants for doctoral studies in the group of educational programs D055-«Oriental studies» write a problematic / thematic essay. The volume of the essay is at least 250-300 words.

The purpose of the essay is to determine the level of analytical and creative abilities, expressed in the ability to build one's own argumentation based on theoretical knowledge, social and personal experience.

Types of essays:

- motivational essay revealing the motivation for research activities;\
- scientific-analytical essay justifying the relevance and methodology of the planned research;
- problem/thematic essay reflecting various aspects of scientific knowledge in the subject area.

Essay: (It is written in one of the eastern languages: Arabic, Chinese, Korean, Japanese, Hindi, Urdu, Persian, and Turkish)

1. Your academic and professional experience, and your vision for future research.
2. About the source base and field research opportunities for your dissertation project? How accessible are they today?
3. What preliminary information you have collected on the research topic, from what databases, in what languages, and from what reputable scientists?
4. What scientific problem you would like to deal with, and what benefits it can bring for the further development of science or society.
5. Justify why your candidacy is the best for admission to doctoral studies
6. How will your experience, knowledge and personal qualities allow you to pursue a PhD, write a scientific dissertation
7. Your intended contribution to the development of one of the areas of Kazakh oriental studies
8. Your main scientific goals, plan for the dissertation realization, available experience on the topic of the supposed scientific research
9. What are your preferences and possible prospects after obtaining a PhD degree? Where and in what form do you see opportunities for successful self-realization?
10. Your thoughts and suggestions on the promotion of Kazakh science in the world community. What real challenges do you see and what solutions do you consider possible for implementation?

2. The electronic examination card consists of 3 questions

Sub-topics: The division of British India into two states and the declaration of independence of Pakistan. Political and socio-economic development and foreign policy of Pakistan during the "Cold War". Domestic and foreign policy of Pakistan at the present stage.

Topic 12. Contemporary history of Turkey.

Subtopics: The National Liberation Movement in Turkey in 1918-23. Ataturk's reforms. Turkey's foreign and domestic policy during the "Cold War". Turkey's foreign and domestic policy at the present stage.

Topic 13. Contemporary history of Afghanistan.

Subtopics: The overthrow of the monarchy in Afghanistan. The April Revolution of 1978. Domestic and foreign policy of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan. The Taliban and their rule in Afghanistan. The overthrow of the Taliban and the development of Afghanistan at the present stage.

Topic 14. Contemporary history of Iran.

Subtopics: Iran's foreign Policy during the "Cold War". The "White Revolution" in Iran. The Islamic Revolution in Iran and changes in the country's foreign and domestic policy.

Topic 1. Modernization in the East: the specifics and experience of the West.

Subtopics: A new paradigm of modernization: redefining the relationship between tradition and modernity. Modernization of East Asia and Confucianism. Comparative analysis of modernization processes in the countries of the East and West from the point of view of civilizational realities. Reforms in the countries of the East. Modernize and give an analysis from the point of view of the interaction of Western and Eastern civilizations.

Subtopics: Characteristic features of traditional political culture. Features of political culture in the countries of the East. Influence of colonialism on traditional political culture. Traditional political culture during the period of independent development of the countries of the East. The influence of the processes of globalization on the political culture of the countries of the East. The concept of political modernization of the East. Rethinking the problems of modernization in Western and Eastern political science at the present stage. The essence of the search for alternative ways of development in accordance with traditional socio-cultural values.

Topic 7. Political system and political culture of Japan.

Subtopics: General characteristics of the political system of Japan. Factors of political stability. Features of the 1947 Constitution. Features of democracy in Japan. Characteristics of the bipolar structure of political power in Japan (1955 - early 90s). The beginning of the "era of the creation of coalition governments in Japan (first half of the 90s)."Features of the traditional political culture of Japan.

Topic 8. Political systems of China and Taiwan in a comparative perspective.

Subtopics: The influence of the Soviet model on the modern political system in China. The CCP is the core of the "people's democratic dictatorship."Socio-political consequences of the "policy of reform and opening up" in China. The political system of the PRC: current state and prospects of evolution. Stages of democratization of Taiwanese society. Taiwan's Political System: The Origins of the Political Miracle. Two states, one political culture: China and Taiwan in a comparative perspective. The so-called "two Chinas" problem and the problem of the evolution of China's political system. Personnel recruitment system and selection of a special type of "stratagem politician". The Chinese diaspora within the "united front" of "Greater China".

The main features of traditional political culture. Features of the functioning of the party system. Signs of evolution from a dominant party system to a bipartisan one.

Political culture of Pakistan and Bangladesh. Religious composition of the population in Pakistan and Bangladesh. Confessional minorities and main trends in South Asian Islam. Features of political culture in certain areas of Pakistan and among different ethnic groups. The political role of Shiism in Pakistan.

Topic 12. Political systems of the countries of Southeast Asia.

Subtopics: Syncretization of Hinayana with Brahmanism and local religious beliefs and its manifestation in politics and public life of the countries of the Indochina Peninsula. Political systems of the main countries of Southeast Asia in a comparative perspective. The role of Confucianism and

Mahayana Buddhism in the formation and functioning of the political system of modern SRV. "Vietnamese specificity" in the context of the state and political development of Southeast Asia at the present stage.

Topic 13. Political systems of Arab countries and Israel.

Subtopics: Political Systems in Arab Countries: A Comparative Analysis. The influence of Islam on the functioning of state institutions in Arab countries. National models of political culture in the Arab countries of North Africa. The problem of political opposition in Arab countries. The historical roots of leadership in the political culture of traditional Arab society and the issue of leadership in Islam.

Topic 14. Political systems of the countries of the Middle East.

Subtopics: Top-down revolutions in the Middle East: tactical setbacks or structural failure? The reasons for the Islamic revival in the Middle East. "Islamic model" in the theory and practice of socio-political development of the Islamic Republic of Iran. Socio-economic and political development of the countries of the Middle East during the period of Islamic rule. The specifics of the political systems of the Middle East.

Topic 15. Political systems of the countries of the East in a comparative perspective.

Subtopics: The social space of the political systems of the countries of the East. Authoritarianism and the system of political representation in the countries of the East. The concept of "waves" of democracy, their nature and content in the East. The role of the state in the transitional societies of the East. Opportunities and Limitations of "Democratic Transit" in the East. Political systems of the countries of the East in a comparative perspective: general and specific. Prospects for the liberalization and democratization of political systems in modern Eastern societies.
